11/30/2022

0013 If you are editing the Schedule Holiday list, you can now de-select July 4th if you wish.


0012 If you enter information for Medical Alert information on a patient's General Info screen, when you select their name slot on the schedule a red "**Med Alert**" will be displayed. You can click on it to see what the Medical Alert info was entered for them.

11/15/2022

0011 You can disable the Table Menu from being available. From the Primary Menu select the "Options" button, then click "Disable Tablet PC Type Menu".

11/08/2022

0010 When you are posting and you get the final **Yes/No** posting question, major computer files are locked until you reply either Yes or No. A new option lets you set the maximum number of seconds the system will wait before defaulting to **No**, thus releasing the systems files. From the "Posting screen" select the top toolbar "Tools" option, then "Options Setups", then set the value of the field show below. This can prevent someone from getting called away during posting and tying your system up.



09/15/2022

0009 The Perio General Legacy program has been improved. It now has a "Recession" button you can use to indicate Recession for each tooth.

0008 The Insurance Carrier Payment Analysis report has improved. Once you display the report you can click on a Carrier Line Entry to view and/or print a list of all patients currently using that carrier.

08/26/2022

0007 On the Posting the Provider/Hygienist Pop Up list screen has increased from 10 entries to 20.

05/15/2022

0006 When using a patient's documents folder, PDF type documents should display **faster**. When you open a PDF in the "**View**" mode, the program "Sumatra" will be used to display the document. This is a faster low overhead program. If you wish to open the document with your default Windows program, just select the "**Edit**" mode instead of "**View**". If you don't like "Sumatra" you can disable it by using the top toolbar "Tools" option, then select "Options Setup", check "Don't Use Sumatra to open PDF type files".

05/05/2022

0005 A new report is option is available on the “Claims Not Submitted” report. You can optionally specify up to 6 different carrier numbers to limit the report too. You can run this report from the “Reports” Menu, then “Insurance Tracking”, and then “Claims Not Submitted”.

04/19/2022

0006 EasyDent now supports the newest NewCrop eScripts which uses a Chromium interface. NewCrop is requiring this interface to be used for eScript by June 1st, 2022. Please contact Data Tec to have your computers updated to use this new interface.

02/09/2022

0005 By default the Schedule will now auto protect any time slots with Account Numbers in them. This means you should not be able to accidentally type over text in a time slot that has an Account Number in it. If for some reason you don’t like this option you can call Data Tec and we can walk you through deactivating it.

01/05/2022

0004 You can set a new Option to automatically start the eScripts Status Bar program for your workstation when you Login. From the “Primary Menu” select the “Options” button, then check the option labeled “Auto Start eScript Status Check”.

01/03/2022

0003 The “Patient Search by Criteria” report has a new criterion “Date Pat Added”.

0002 When you add a new patient to the system, the date you added them or created their account it automatically kept. If you place the mouse over the account number field on the General screen, the date they we added will be displayed in the pop-up help hint.

01/02/2022

0001 Scanning documents at a “Resolution DPI” greater than 200 typically wastes tons of disk space without improving the quality of the scan very much. Therefore, on the document management screens when you us the scan feature if the “Resolution DPI” is set higher than 200, a warning message will automatically appear. You can ignore it or click on the message to set the “Resolution DPI” to 200.
